Philosophical Atheism

Pantheistic – everything is god

**Brahman** - “World Soul,” impersonal

- Brahma – personal creator god

- Vishnu – preserver god

- Shiva – destroyer god

Hinduism - Lesser gods are part of ultimate reality, "300 million gods"

Devotion to a god helps bring salvation

Statues of gods are cared for to please the god

# Salvation

Each person has a soul (atman) that is actually part of the ultimate reality (brahman), but we fail to recognize our place in the ultimate

# Salvation

Life is an illusion (maya) that keeps us from becoming one with the ultimate reality (brahman)

**karma** - the sum of a person's actions in this and previous states of existence, viewed as deciding their fate in future existences.

Cause and Effect

Not Judgement or Fate

- Worship of a deity, book – Right Worship/Devotion

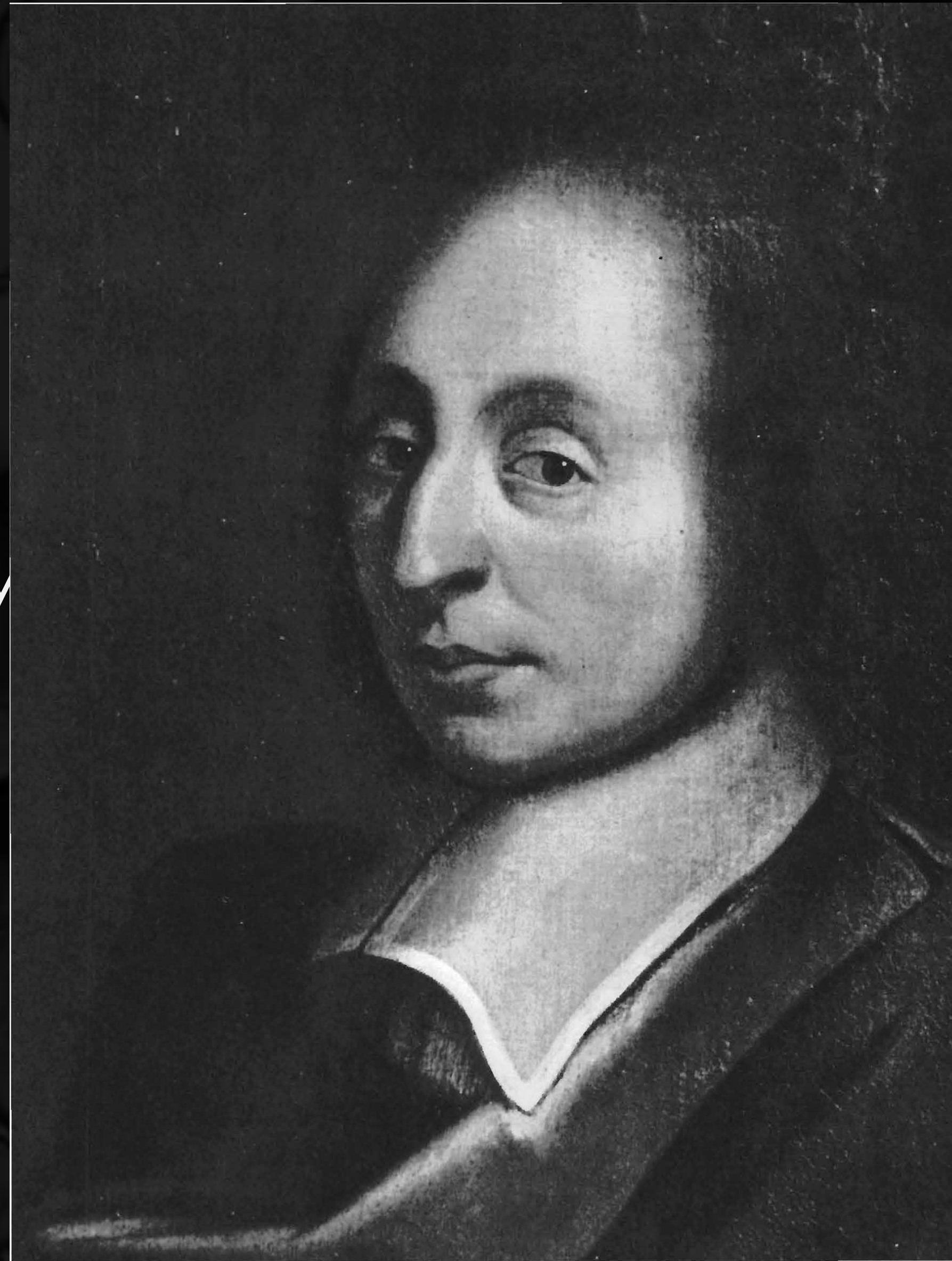
