John 14:26 (CSB)

But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and remind you of everything I have told you.



Who is the Holy Spirit?



The Holy Spirit is a Person

John 14:15–17 (CSB)



“If you love me, you will keep my commands.

*And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another **Counselor** to be with you forever.*

***He** is the Spirit of truth. The world is unable to receive **him** because it doesn't see **him** or know **him**. But you do know **him**, because **he** remains with you and will be in you.”*



He has a will

1 Corinthians 12:11 (CSB)

One and the same Spirit is active in all these, distributing to each person as he wills.



He speaks

Acts 13:2 (CSB)

*As they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the **Holy Spirit said**, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."*



He can be grieved

Ephesians 4:30 (CSB)

And don't grieve God's Holy Spirit. You were sealed by him for the day of redemption.

Acts 5:3–4 (CSB)

*“Ananias,” Peter asked, “why has Satan filled your heart to **lie to the Holy Spirit** and keep back part of the proceeds of the land?*

*Wasn't it yours while you possessed it? And after it was sold, wasn't it at your disposal? Why is it that you planned this thing in your heart?
You have not lied to people but to God.”*

Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

*Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness covered the surface of the watery depths, and **the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters.***



Genesis 1:26a (CSB)

Omniscient

1 Corinthians 2:10 (CSB)

Now God has revealed these things to us by the Spirit, since the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God.

Omnipotent



Zechariah 4:6 (CSB)

So he answered me, "This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: 'Not by strength or by might, but by my Spirit,' says the LORD of Armies.



The Holy Spirit is Counselor



John 14:26 (CSB)

But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and remind you of everything I have told you.



John 15:26 (CSB)

“When the Counselor comes, the one I will send to you from the Father—the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father—he will testify about me.”

John 16:13–14 (CSB)



When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth. For he will not speak on his own, but he will speak whatever he hears. He will also declare to you what is to come.

He will glorify me, because he will take from what is mine and declare it to you.

John 7:38–39 (CSB)



“The one who believes in me, as the Scripture has said, will have streams of living water flow from deep within him.”

He said this about the Spirit. Those who believed in Jesus were going to receive the Spirit, for the Spirit had not yet been given because Jesus had not yet been glorified.



1 Corinthians 12:13 (CSB)

For we were all baptized by (in, through) one Spirit into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and we were all given one Spirit to drink.



Ephesians 1:13–14 (CSB)

*In him you also **were sealed** with the promised Holy Spirit **when you heard** the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and **when you believed.***

The Holy Spirit is the down payment of our inheritance, until the redemption of the possession, to the praise of his glory.

Titus 3:4–6 (CSB)



*But when the kindness of God our Savior
and his love for mankind appeared,
he saved us—not by works of righteousness
that we had done, but according to his
mercy—through the washing of
regeneration and renewal by the Holy Spirit.
He poured out his Spirit on us abundantly
through Jesus Christ our Savior*
